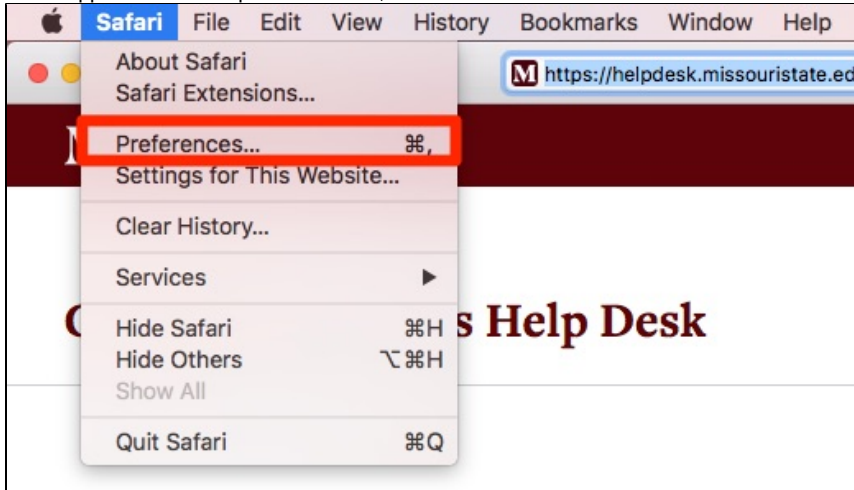

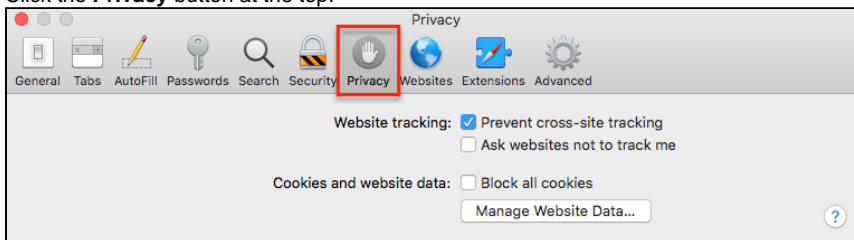

Step-by-step guide

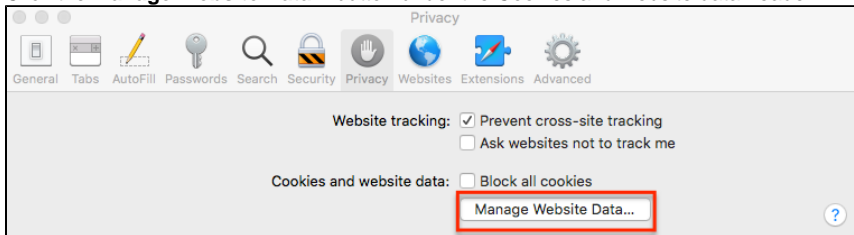
1. In the Apple bar at the top of the screen, click **Safari > Preferences...**



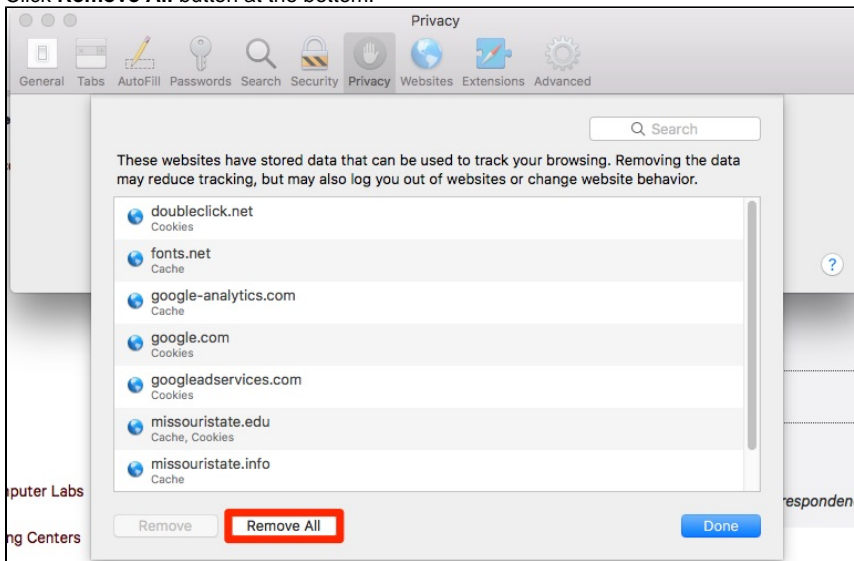
2. Click the **Privacy** button at the top.



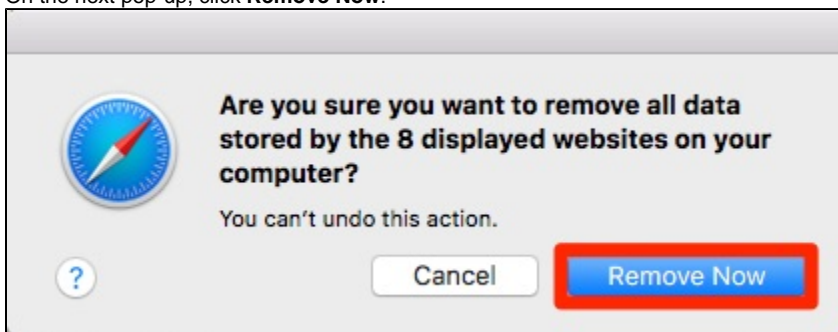
3. Click the **Manage Website Data...** button under the Cookies and website data header.



4. Click **Remove All** button at the bottom.



5. On the next pop-up, click **Remove Now**.
