


How to remove student(s) from the group.

1. In your BlackBoard course, go to "Groups" under "Users and Groups" in **Control Panel**

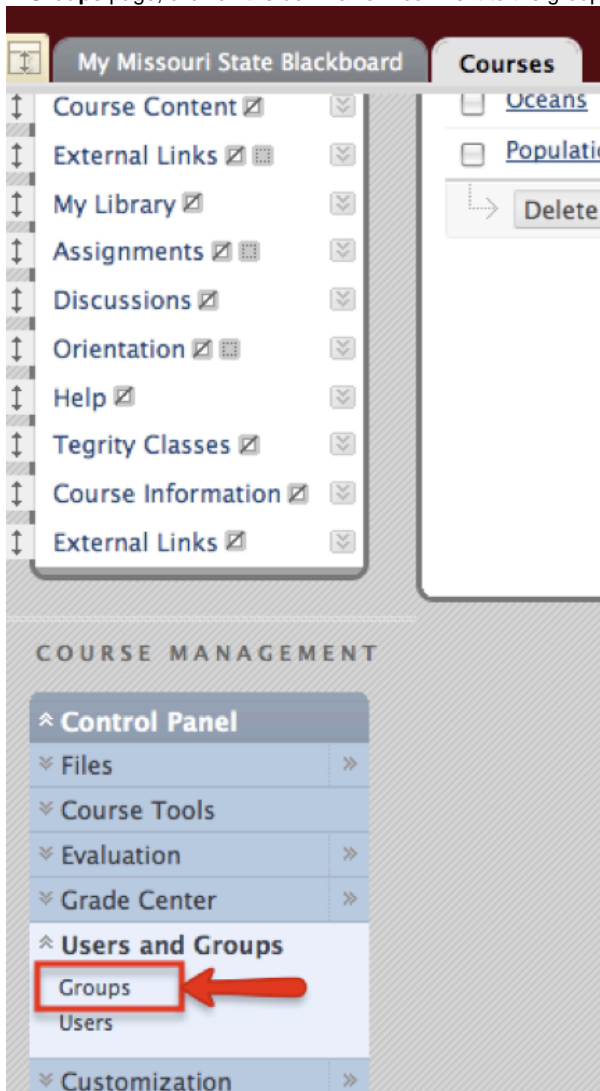
