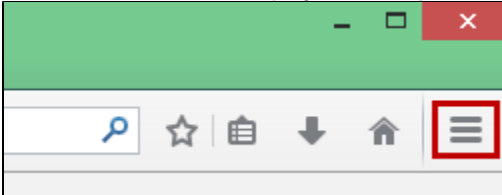

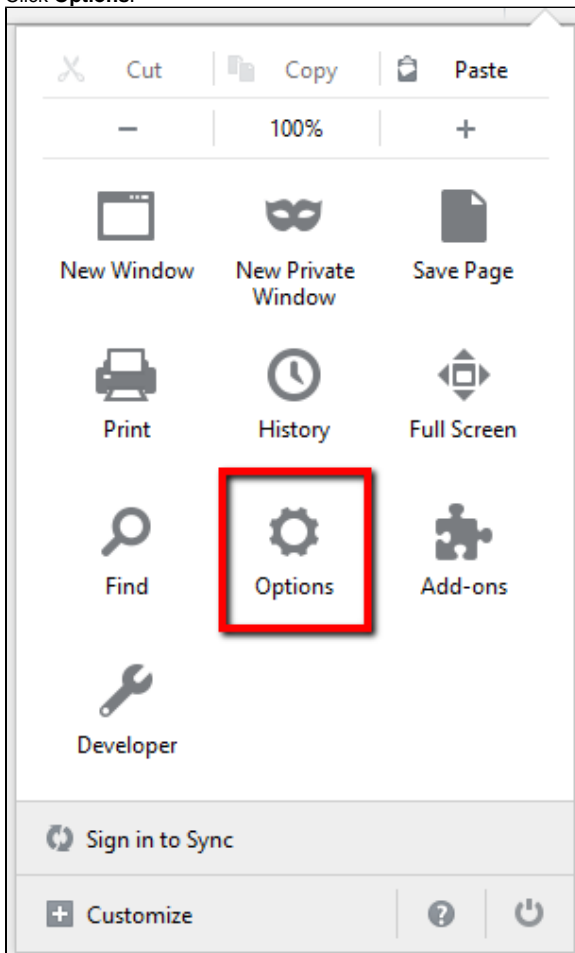

Step-by-step guide

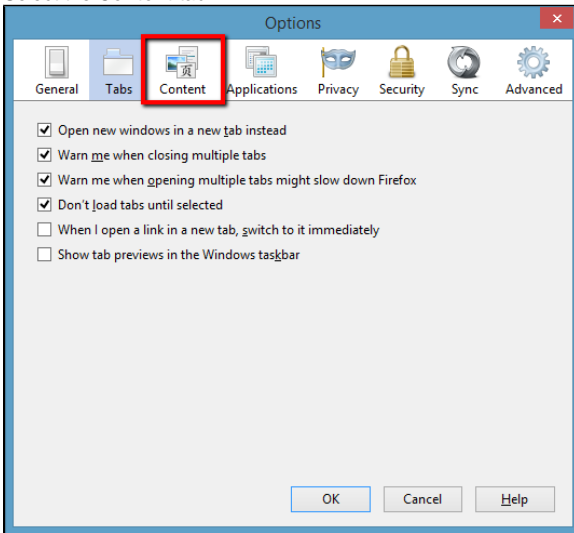
1. Click the menu button in the top-right corner of your browser window.
